- A copy of your most recent high school transcript, or other "official school document" showing your unweighted GPA.

However, the completed package may be placed in the SAMS mailbox located outside of the church offices near the reception desk. This must be done by the above deadline!

Within 10 days of mailing or delivering your application, you should receive notification via an e-mail or phone call that your application has been received. If you do not receive notification within 7 days of mailing/delivering your application, you should contact me at 919-469-8264.

All submissions will be reviewed for eligibility and all decisions by the scholarship committee are final. This year the scholarship program will award one \$500.00 scholarship and two smaller scholarship awards if funds are available.

Announcement of the winner and presentation of the awards will be at a specified time and location in late June or early July. The date will be set soon after all applications are received.
