





Psalm 23: The Lord Is My Shepherd




- 1. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. In verdant pastures he gives me repose; beside restful waters he leads me; he refreshes my soul.




Profession of Faith: Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.




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

Act of Spiritual Communion


